

MINUTES OF THE CROCKETT CITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THE 19<sup>th</sup> DAY OF APRIL 2004 IN THE CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, LOCATED AT 200 NORTH FIFTH IN THE CITY OF CROCKETT, HOUSTON COUNTY TEXAS AT 12:00 NOON.

THE COUNCIL MET IN SPECIAL SESSION WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: WAYNE MASK, JACK SHIVELEY, DARRELL JONES, NATHAN GARDNER, MARGARET BURNETT & CHUCK CUNNINGHAM. CITY OFFICIALS PRESENT: CITY ADMINISTRATOR RONALD DUNCAN, CITY SECRETARY MITZI THOMPSON AND CORPORAL MICHAEL HARRELL.

5. AWARD BID: 2003 TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

Mr. Bob Thurber with KSA Engineers explained to council that the purpose of this Project will be to diversify the flow from the South Side Treatment Plant to the North Side Treatment Plant in order to prolong the life of the South Plant. The bids are within the budget for the project. Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Shiveley to award the bid for Schedule No. 1 – Materials Procurement to Rural Pipe and Supply in the amount of \$86,233.00 and to award the bid for Schedule No. 2 – Submersible Pump Installation to Duplichain Contractors in the amount of \$119,600.00. Motion seconded by Council member Jones. Motion passes 5-0.
