**Job Summary**: This position uses technical expertise to assist with maintaining and operating the City's wastewater treatment plant system in a safe, effective, and efficient manner. Duties include, but are not limited to, daily monitoring of plant equipment, conducting routine tests and instrument readings, calibrating lab test equipment, collecting and analyzing samples, cleaning and maintaining mechanical equipment, facilities, and grounds, and making process control changes as needed and assist with permit compliance. Work involves compiling and recording data, performing calculations, preparing written reports, and establishing and complying with an equipment maintenance plan and schedule.

Work may be performed independently within established guidelines and may be reviewed during progress and upon completion. May be required to work more than 40 hours per week and will be required to be on-call on a rotational basis to respond to emergency situations and for special events.

<u>Work Environment</u>: Work involves using proper safety precautions while being frequently exposed to wet and/or humid conditions, moving mechanical parts, high, precarious places, fumes or airborne particles, toxic or caustic chemicals, explosives and vibrations, extreme cold and heat, with risk of electrical shock. The noise level in the work environment is usually loud.

**<u>Required Education and Experience</u>**: High school diploma or equivalent. Valid Texas Driver License. Two years related experience. Higher education, including technical school training, may substitute for experience on a year-for-year or proportionate basis. Must possess a TCEQ "C" Wastewater License.

**Preferred Education and Experience**: TCEQ "B" Wastewater License. Commercial Driver's License.
